MINUTES

The Richfield Village Parks and Recreation Board meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm.

ROLL CALL: Present were Keppler, Sullivan, Daniels and Kovak. Also present were Mayor Beshara, Councilperson Dr. Dominick and Jocek.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A MOTION was made by Keppler and second by Sullivan to approve the February 5th , 2018 minutes as read. Motion approved.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Jocek reported on the upcoming programs: The Easter Egg Hunt, 11 am at the Town Hall Pavilion and Egg Dying, 1 pm at the Masonic Hall will be on Saturday, March 24th , 2018.

The next event will be The ART Show that will take place at Masonic Hall on Saturday, April 14, 2018. This will have watercolorists, potter's, jewelry and many more artists. It will take place from 10 am until 4 pm.

On Saturday, April 21, 2018 we are sponsoring Community, Project Pride, Clean up Richfield. This program runs from 9 am until Noon at the Town Hall Pavilion. We are asking residents to pick up trash bags from us and request a location to pick up trash.

Also on Saturday, April 21, 2018 we will be celebrating the 5th anniversary of the Carter/Pedigo Tr. story boards. We will walk the trail and read the Lorax and each participant will receive a tree to plant on the trail or to plant in a pot onsite to take home.

Our Arbor Day Tree Giveaway will be held this year on Saturday, April 28th , 2018 at the Town Hall Pavilion. There will be a variety of trees to receive or pick from. This event starts at 9 am and ends when the trees are given away.

We will be starting a new Eagle Scout project this spring. The gentleman will build garden boxes at the Eastwood Preserve community garden for special needs children.

MAYOR'S REPORT: Beshara reported that the Village is up 10.7% for the year. Jocek is applying for NOPEC money to help pay for the concerts this summer.

At the Revere School board meeting there was concern for the safety of the children as in reference to the design of the new school buildings. Also that Bath School could be called Revere Elementary.

Beshara reported that there could be an announcement about the water tower soon.
