




The production, transmission and delivery of natural gas and electricity requires locating transmission lines, pipelines, substations and other critical facilities throughout a vast geographical region.

These facilities are important to the American economy and our everyday lives, and we take security responsibilities for them very seriously.


We ask your help in protecting these vital parts of America's infrastructure by participating in our **Neighborhood Watch**. Be a good neighbor.

If you see out-of-the-ordinary or suspicious activity near a Dominion facility, call **1-800-684-8486**. Of course, in an emergency you should always call **911**.



The Seven Signs of Terrorism

1. **Surveillance**—Recording or monitoring activities, drawing diagrams or annotating on maps, in possession of a Dominion facility blueprint, etc.
2. **Information Gathering**—Trying to gain information or knowledge about a Dominion facility or the people who work there
3. **Testing Security**—Watching to see how long it takes emergency responders to get to a scene; measuring reaction time
4. **Planning/Acquiring Supplies**—Purchase or theft of explosives, weapons, or ammunition; also storage of harmful chemicals or equipment
5. **Suspicious People Who Don't Belong**—People who don't seem to belong in the workplace, neighborhood, business establishment, or who demonstrate odd behavior
6. **Rehearsal/Dry Run**—Practice session run before final operation or plan; monitoring police radio frequency or recording emergency response times; mapping routes and traffic flow
7. **Deploying Assets/Getting Into Position**—People and supplies getting into position to commit the final action. This is the last chance to alert Dominion Corporate Security or law enforcement before terrorist act occurs.

Report **any unusual signs** to Dominion Corporate Security, no matter how insignificant they might appear to be, since indicators may come months or even years before an incident occurs.



When reporting any **suspicious activity**

Describe:

- What happened
- Where it happened
- When it occurred
- How many people were involved

When observing a **person**

Note personal characteristics:

- Age
- Gender
- Body art, piercings, tattoos
- Build
- Hair color/length
- Clothing
- Height/weight
- Facial features
- Race, ethnicity

When a **vehicle** is involved

Remember specific features such as:

- Make, model and color
- License plate number and state
- Bumper stickers
- Body damage
