

RESOLUTION NO. 67-2016

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF SPANO BROTHERS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SPANO BROTHERS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG BRECKSVILLE ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for the installation of sidewalks along Brecksville Road; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received a bid from Spano Brothers Construction Company in the amount of \$174,070.00 for said installation of said sidewalks as is set forth in the Award Recommendation letter attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Village staff has recommended that the bid of Spano Brothers Construction Company be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, This Council wishes to accept the bid of Spano Brothers Construction Company for the installation of sidewalks along Brecksville Road in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seventy Dollars (\$174,070.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to accept the bid of Spano Brothers Construction Company in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seventy Dollars (\$174,070.00) to install sidewalks along Brecksville Road.


SECTION 2: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Spano Brothers Construction Company in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Seventy Dollars (\$174,070.00) for the installation of sidewalks along Brecksville Road.

SECTION 3: That there be appropriated from the Sidewalk Fund: Cost of Operations the sum of Fifty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$56,490.25); and that there be appropriated from the Income Tax Fund and transferred to: the Sidewalk Fund the sum of Fifty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$56,490.25).

SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to install said sidewalks at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
