

RESOLUTION NO. 65-2016

OFFERED BY All of Council

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR THE INTERIM SERVICE DIRECTOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, after the resignation of the prior Service Director, the Mayor appointed Brian Frantz as Interim Service Director, with Village Council's confirmation; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Frantz is fulfilling the duties of Service Director while maintaining his position and job duties as Director of Planning and Zoning; and

WHEREAS, Village Council recognizes that Mr. Frantz's extensive work during the time he will serve as Interim Service Director imposes an unanticipated burden on Mr. Frantz; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended and Village Council desires to compensate Mr. Frantz for his services as Interim Service Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Brian Frantz shall be provided \$978.36 per pay period for the services he is providing as Interim Service Director in addition to his compensation as Director of Planning and Zoning; such payment shall commence as soon as practical, shall be retroactive to August 17, 2016, and shall be treated as additional payroll wages with all appropriate deductions being made.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to fairly compensate Brian Frantz for fulfilling the duties of Service Director while maintaining his position and job duties as Director of Planning and Zoning; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


