

RESOLUTION NO. 31-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION TO THE SUMMIT/AKRON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY FOR A REWORKS COMMUNITY RECYCLING ASSISTANCE GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE GRANT FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor and the Finance Director to apply to the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a ReWorks Community Recycling Assistance Grant to be applied toward the recycling portion of the Village contract with Rumpke of Northern Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor and Finance Director to accept said grant funds from the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a ReWorks Community Recycling Assistance Grant in the amount of Three Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$3,648.00) to be offset against the cost of the Village's trash/recycling expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Finance Director to submit an application to the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a ReWorks Community Recycling Assistance Grant to be applied towards the recycling portion of the Village's contract with Rumpke of Northern Ohio.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they are, authorized and directed to accept the grant funds from the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a ReWorks Community Recycling Assistance Grant in the amount of Three Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$3,648.00) to assist with the cost of the Village's trash/recycling expenses.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the ReWorks grant application is submitted prior to the deadline therefor and that the Village can accept the grant funds; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and

execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
