

A RESOLUTION DECLARING NINE MOBILE VIDEO RECORDER SYSTEMS AND OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO SELL SAID PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Revised Code §721.15 allows for this Council to adopt a Resolution authorizing the sale of personal property, including motor vehicles, and other personal property and equipment, referenced in Revised Code §721.15, which is no longer needed for public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired, by Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council has adopted a resolution authorizing the sale of surplus Village personal property which is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired by Internet auction in 2017, and authorized the Mayor to select a representative to conduct such Internet auctions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has selected GovDeals.com to conduct said Internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council has received a recommendation from the Police Chief that the mobile video recorders and other personal property set forth in attached "Exhibit A" are no longer needed for public use, are obsolete, or are unfit for the use for which they were acquired, and, thus are surplus property that should be disposed of.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. Based upon the recommendation of the Police Chief, this Council finds that the mobile video recorders and other personal property, set forth in attached "Exhibit A," are no longer needed for public use, are obsolete, or are unfit for the use for which they were acquired, and, thus are surplus property and available for disposition by Internet auction and that an Internet auction shall be conducted by GovDeals.com, as selected by the Mayor based upon the recommendations of the Finance Director and Police Chief.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the Village can expeditiously dispose of the obsolete mobile video recorders and other personal property via Internet auction; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council

elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


