

RESOLUTION NO. 68 -2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY TO THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY ("AMATS") FOR A GRANT OF FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION FUNDS FOR WHEATLEY ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


WHEREAS, the Mayor has been advised by AMATS that applications under the AMATS Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for funding for the Wheatley Road Improvement Project in furtherance of the Crossroad District Plan must be submitted by October 31, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:


- SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to make application to AMATS for federal funds under the AMATS Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Wheatley Road Improvement project in furtherance of the Crossroad District Plan, which project has an estimated cost of approximately \$7 million.
- SECTION 2. That the Village acknowledges and understands the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to meet the October 31, 2017 deadline for application; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


