

RESOLUTION NO. 78-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) FORD EXPLORER FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM MONTROSE FORD THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is a member of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to contract to purchase one (1) new Ford Explorer from Montrose Ford under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase one (1) new Ford Explorer from Montrose Ford, for an amount not to exceed \$34,000, under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2. That because this purchase is made under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program, this Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding pursuant to Section 141.03(f) of the Richfield Codified Ordinances.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to facilitate the acquisition of the Ford Explorer at the earliest possible time to replace a similar vehicle that was totaled in an accident which was not the Village's fault; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect ~~on the date of the Village Council meeting~~ <sup>3844 Governor's</sup> ~~of Richfield, Ohio, hereby certify that the foregoing~~ <sup>of Richfield, Ohio, hereby certify that the foregoing</sup> earliest period allowed by law.
