

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) KDW1003 HUSTLER UTILITY MDV WITH HITCH KIT FROM BAKER VEHICLE THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is a member of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to contract to purchase one (1) new KDW1003 Hustler Utility MDV with hitch kit from Baker Vehicle, 9035 Freeway Drive, Macedonia, Ohio 44056, under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and


WHEREAS, this purchase was approved as a part of the 2018 capital improvement budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- SECTION 1. The Mayor and the Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase one (1) new KDW1003 Hustler Utility MDV with hitch kit from Baker Vehicle, 9035 Freeway Drive, Macedonia, Ohio 44056, for a total amount not to exceed \$21,359.00, under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program, as set forth in the proposal attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated fully herein by reference.
- SECTION 2. That because this purchase is made under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program, this Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding or quotes pursuant to Section 141.03(f) of the Richfield Codified Ordinances.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason to acquire needed equipment for the Service Department at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon passage and execution by the Mayor;

otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


