

RESOLUTION NO. 56 -2018

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF CAVANAUGH BUILDING CORPORATION FOR THE REPAIR OF THE HUMPHREY ROAD CULVERT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisements on May 30, 2018 and June 6, 2018, competitive bids were received for the repair and reconstruction of the storm water drainage culvert in the vicinity of 4053 Humphrey Road, which has deteriorated to the point of failure; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the three (3) bids received, all exceeded the Engineer's estimated cost of construction by more than 10%, such that ordinarily the project would be re-bid; and

WHEREAS, due to the further deterioration in the condition of the Humphrey Road culvert, the situation is now an emergency such that the road has been closed for public safety reasons; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 735.051, in the case of a real and present emergency the Village Council may by a two-thirds vote of all members elected thereto authorize a contract for emergency work to be performed without formal bidding and advertising; and

WHEREAS, this Council determines, based on the report and recommendation of the Engineer and Interim Service Director, that a real and present emergency exists due to the deteriorating storm drainage culvert in the vicinity of 4053 Humphrey Road; and

WHEREAS, under these circumstances, based upon the recommendation of the Engineer attached hereto as Exhibit A, the Service Director recommends awarding the contract to Cavanaugh Building Corporation in accordance with its bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That a real and present emergency exists in connection with the storm water culvert in the vicinity of 4053 Humphrey Road.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized to enter into a contract with Cavanaugh Building Corporation in the amount of \$195,496.00, based upon the bid obtained by the Village's Engineer and Interim Service Director, without necessity of further formal bidding and advertisement efforts, which requirements are hereby waived.


SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further

reason that it is immediately necessary in order to repair and reconstruct the storm water drainage culvert in the vicinity of 4053 Humphrey Road; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


