

RESOLUTION NO. 100-2014

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN POLICE VEHICLES SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SELL THE VEHICLES AT AUCTION AND APPLY THE PROCEEDS TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND TO PURCHASE THREE NEW POLICE VEHICLES FROM MONTROSE AUTO GROUP THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is a member of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield wishes to purchase two new Ford Taurus police vehicles and one Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicle from Montrose Auto Group;

WHEREAS, this Council, upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, has determined that the following police vehicles identified by the following vehicle identification numbers have become obsolete and are no longer useful to the Village: 2003 Ford Explorer VIN 1FMZU72K13UB97515; 2003 Ford Explorer VIN 1FMZU72K13UB97516; and 2009 Ford Crown Victoria VIN 2FAHP71V49X110491; and

WHEREAS, WHEREAS, this Council authorizes the Chief of Police to sell at auction, the three police vehicles identified herein to offset the purchase of two Ford Taurus police vehicles and one Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicle, at the best possible price.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase two Ford Taurus police vehicles and one Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicle from Montrose Auto Group, for a 2015 delivery date, for a total not to exceed \$107,000.00, under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2. That the following vehicles used by the Village Police Department are hereby declared surplus property, no longer of useful service to the Village:


SECTION 3. That the Mayor and Finance Director are hereby authorized and directed to sell the above listed vehicles at auction, for the best possible price, and to apply the proceeds of the sale toward the Capital Improvement Fund of the Village of Richfield.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order for the new police vehicles to be in use at the earliest possible time in the interest of public safety; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


