<p>On 10/18/2019 at approximately 0250 hrs., dispatch advised they received a call in regard to a car in the median on Interstate 77 that was "pretty smashed up." Officer Gaydosh left the Richfield Police Department and made his way up to Interstate 77.</p> <p>Officer Gaydosh observed a vehicle in the median on I-77 near mile marker 144. Officer Gaydosh approached the vehicle and advised dispatch that the vehicle struck the guardrail and vertical posts. Officer Gaydosh also advised dispatch that the keys were still in the ignition and there were empty beer cans inside the vehicle.</p> <p>The registration on the vehicle was Ohio GCT8231. The vehicle was registered to Patricia L. Pickett, who resides in Bath Twp., Ohio. I had dispatch contact Bath Police dispatch and to have an officer respond to their residence and make contact with the owner of the vehicle. Dispatch was also able to locate a public service number for the owner. (330-576-6418)</p> <p>At approximately 0315 hrs., I contacted Tom Pickett in regard to the incident. I advised him we found a vehicle registered to Patricia Pickett, the wife, that was involved in an accident on Interstate 77. Mr. Pickett advised me that his son, Tyler Pickett, uses that car to drive to work. Tom advised me that Tyler works at the Jukebox in Cleveland, Ohio and works late hours. I asked Mr. Pickett for Tyler's phone number and he gave me Tyler's number. Tom asked if there were any injuries and if his son was OK and I advised him that the car was abandoned and no one was around. I did advise him that Officer Gaydosh did check the immediate area. I advised Tom that if Tyler returns home to contact me immediately. Tom acknowledged.</p> <p>At Approximately 0400 hrs., Tom contacted me at the Richfield Police Department. Tom stated that Tyler was home and "that he did not have a scratch on him." Tom also advised me that Tyler was walking down Cleveland-Massillon Road near Ken Stewarts and Tom picked him up and took him home. Tom also advised me that Tyler stated he was at a party and he let his friend "Matt" use the vehicle. Tyler did not know "Matt's" last name or contact information. I advised Tom I need Tyler to come up to the Richfield Police Department so I can receive a statement in regard to what happened. I advised Tom I will be at the police department until 0600 hrs. Tom and Tyler did not come to the Richfield Police Department during the time I was there.</p> <p>Tom and Tyler Pickett came up later in the day and spoke to Officer Randolph. Officer Randolph received a written statement from both individuals.</p> <p>On October 21, 2019 at 2220 hrs. I contacted the Jukebox in Cleveland Ohio. I spoke with the owner Alex Budin. I asked Mr. Budin if Tyler Pickett is an employee there. Mr. Budin stated Tyler is an employee and he is a server. I asked Mr. Budin if Tyler was at work on the evening of Thursday October 17th, 2019. Mr. Budin stated that Tyler was working at the Jukebox until 0200 hrs. (October 18th, 2019) and left. Mr. Budin stated he checked security camera footage and observed Tyler leaving at that time. Mr. Budin did state that he was aware of the situation and Tyler told him he went to a party and lent his car to a friend and he wrecked the vehicle.</p> <p>The Jukebox is located at 1404 W 29th St, Cleveland, OH 44113.</p> <p>All phone calls were made on a recorded line.</p>

<p>On 10/18/2019 Tyler Pickett and father Thomas Pickett came into the police station to pickup the tow release sheet. While on station both individuals were questioned about the incident. Tyler stated that on 10/17/2019 he was working in Cleveland and after work he ran into a friend named "Matt". Tyler stated that Matt told him of a house party going on in Richfield and asked if he wanted to go. Tyler said yes and went to the party with Matt.</p> <p>While at the house party, Tyler stated that Matt asked to use his vehicle to take two girls up the road to their nearby residence. Tyler advised that he allowed Matt to take his car and the girls up the road. This was the last time he saw Matt. Tyler advised that he believes Matt wrecked his vehicle shortly after.</p> <p>Tyler stated that he does not know Matt's last name or phone number. He also stated that he didn't know either of the two girls Matt took with him. He further stated that he didn't know anyone at the house party and also advised he didn't know the address of the party. The only information pertaining to the location of the party was that he thought it was off Wheatley Rd.</p> <p>Witness statement forms were obtained from Tyler and Thomas Pickett.</p>
