

RESOLUTION NO. 27-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, INC., LODGE 66, FOR THE YEARS 2015 THROUGH 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor has negotiated a collective bargaining agreement with representatives of the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc., Lodge 66, for the period of April 20, 2015 through December 31, 2017, the terms of which have been reviewed by Council; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. This Council hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor to enter into a collective bargaining agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc., Lodge 66, setting forth salary, hours, terms and conditions of employment with the Village, to be effective as of April 20, 2015 and to remain in effect through December 31, 2017, in accordance with the agreement on file with the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein fully by reference.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize an agreement for employment conditions for members of the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc., Lodge 66, as the same affects the day-to-day operations of the Village and its safety forces; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
