

ORDINANCE NO. 36-2007

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 131.01 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF MAYOR FOR THE TERM COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2008 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council believes that it should establish the compensation for the position of Mayor for the term commencing January 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, in fixing the compensation for Mayor, this Council wishes to comply with the requirement of Section 19.11 of the Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 131.01 of the Administrative Code be amended to read as follows:

“131.01 MAYOR – COMPENSATION.

For the term commencing January 1, 2004~~8~~, the compensation of the Mayor shall be \$~~36,000~~ 45,000 annually, together with such other benefits as are received by the full-time employees of the Village. Commencing January 1, 200~~5~~9, for the year 200~~5~~9, the compensation of the Mayor shall be increased on the same percentage basis as is applicable to all full-time employees of the Village.”

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to comply Section 19.11 of the Charter except that the compensation provisions set forth herein shall take effect and be in force from January 1, 2008 and thereafter.
