

RESOLUTION NO. 32-2012

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A CANINE POLICE VEHICLE OBSOLETE AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO TRADE-IN THE VEHICLE TO OFF-SET THE COST OF THE PURCHASE OF TWO NEW POLICE VEHICLES UNDER THE STATE CUE GROUP PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by Resolution 7-2012, passed February 7, 2012 this Council authorized and directed the Chief of Police to purchase two new police vehicles from Montrose Ford through the State CUE program.

WHEREAS, this Council, upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, has determined that the 2007 Dodge Magnum canine police vehicle, VIN 2D4GV47257H630491, has become obsolete and is no longer useful to the Village.

WHEREAS, this Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to trade-in said canine police vehicle to offset the purchase of the new police vehicles, at the best possible rate but not less than \$3,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the 2007 Dodge Magnum canine police vehicle, VIN 2D4GV47257H630491, is hereby declared obsolete and no longer needed by the Village.

SECTION 2. That the Chief of Police be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to trade-in said canine police vehicle to off-set the cost of purchasing new police vehicles pursuant to Ordinance 7-2012, at the best rate possible but not less than \$3,500.00.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason, it is immediately necessary in order to ensure that the acquisition of new police vehicles is accomplished at the earliest possible time with the trade-in properly credited against that purchase; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
