

RESOLUTION NO. 61-2007

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO R.C. §709.03 INDICATING THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION TO 32.3079 ACRES SITUATED AT 4065 BRUSH ROAD, RICHFIELD, OHIO (PERMANENT PARCEL NO. 48-00960) UPON ANNEXATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Revised Code §709.03, this Council is required to provide a statement to the Summit County Council of what services the municipal corporation will provide and an approximate date by which it will provide them to the territory proposed to be annexed which is 32.3079 acres situated at 4065 Brush Road, Richfield, Ohio (Permanent Parcel No. 48-00960).


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That immediately upon annexation, all Village services, including police, fire, service, EMS, garbage disposal, etc., will be provided to the territory proposed for annexation, being 32.3079 acres situated at 4065 Brush Road, Richfield, Ohio (Permanent Parcel No. 48-00960).

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to be effective twenty days before the Summit County Council hearing; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
