A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF CAVANAUGH BUILDING CORPORATION FOR CONSTRUCTION WORK FOR THE PEDIGO CARTER PROPERTY TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received on May 2, 2012, for the Pedigo Carter Property Trail Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended acceptance of the bid of Cavanaugh Building Corporation as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Cavanaugh Building Corporation for construction work on the Pedigo Carter Property Trail Improvement Project in the combined amount of \$209,535.00, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Cavanaugh Building Corporation for construction work on the Pedigo Carter Property Trail Improvement Project.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow a necessary public project to proceed at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
