

ORDINANCE NO. 47-2006

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF A FIRE SAFETY OFFICER

WHEREAS, this council has received information from the Fire Chief concerning the creation of the position of a Fire Safety Officer; and

WHEREAS, it is envisioned that the Fire Safety Officer will provide essential educational services concerning teaching fire safety; and

WHEREAS, the primary emphasis of teaching fire safety would take place in the Revere Local School District; and

WHEREAS, other fire safety educational opportunities may be assigned to the Fire Safety Officer from time to time by the Fire Chief including teaching fire safety at nursing home and other community groups; and

WHEREAS, the position of Fire Safety Officer will be a position shared with Bath Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. That a new Section 147.10 of the Administrative Code be enacted to read as follows:

147.10 – FIRE SAFETY OFFICER

There is hereby created the position of Fire Safety Officer. The Mayor, with the advice of the Fire Chief, shall create a job description for the Fire Safety Officer to include providing educational services to the community including the Revere Local School District, and community-based organizations. The Fire Chief may enter into such agreements as may be necessary with Bath Township for the sharing of duties of the Fire Safety Officer.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
