A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF THE OLDE ORCHARD PHASE I SUBDIVISION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the developer of the Olde Orchard Phase I Subdivision has offered the streets and public utilities therein for dedication; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director and the Village Engineer have recommended acceptance of dedication; and

WHEREAS, the maintenance bond has been filed by the developer in accordance with the Village's Subdivision Regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Olde Orchard Phase I Subdivision dedication be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to protect the public safety by enforcing the Village's traffic regulations at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote to two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
