A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BATH TOWNSHIP TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION FOR TEENAGE YOUTHS

WHEREAS, the governments of Bath Township and Richfield Village desire to establish a commission for the teenage youths in their respective communities; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Bath-Richfield Youth Commission is to provide for the teens to have a larger voice in their respective community, especially on issues that impact youth; and

WHEREAS, in addition to increasing youth involvement within the communities, the Youth Commission will help prepare the community young people for life and for positions of leadership.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Bath Township to form the Bath-Richfield Youth Commission, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

## AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October, 2006 between Bath Township and Richfield Village for the purpose of employing a facilitator for the Bath-Richfield Youth Commission.

Whereas, the governments of Bath Township and Richfield Village desires to establish a commission for the teenage youths in their respective communities.

Whereas, the purpose of the Bath-Richfield Youth Commission is to provide for the teens to have a larger voice in their respective community, especially on issues that impact youth.

Whereas, in addition to increasing youth involvement within the communities, the Youth Commission will help prepare the community young people for life and for positions of leadership.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the abovementioned purpose the parties herein agree that:


1. A facilitator shall be employed by the Village of Richfield pursuant to their employment provisions and the attached job description titled Exhibit A.
2. The facilitator shall be paid the amount of \$2,900 for his/her services.
3. The Village of Richfield shall in turn bill Bath Township quarterly for the facilitator's services.
4. Richfield Village shall submit a yearly progress report on the Youth Commission to Bath Township.

Further, in the event that either party fails to perform as provided herein, the non-breaching party, at its option, may terminate the agreement upon thirty (30) days notice.

This agreement may be renewed annually based upon written consent of the parties.
