

RESOLUTION NO. 84-2006

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO, TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of addressing local needs; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield, Ohio, desires to receive financial assistance for Hazardous Substance Assessment under the USEPA; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the USEPA; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Richfield must direct and authorize the Mayor to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, hereby authorizes Mayor Michael Lyons to participate in the USEPA Hazardous Substances Community-Wide Assessment Grant application process and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for Hazardous Substance Community-Wide Assessment Grant submission.
- SECTION 2. That the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, hereby authorizes the Mayor to submit an application for financial assistance under the USEPA Hazardous Substance Community-Wide Assessment Grant program.
- SECTION 3. That the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, hereby understands and agrees that participation in the Program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to clean up hazardous substances at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor;

otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
