

A RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF WET REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKINGS ALONG INTERSTATE ROUTE 77 AND STATE ROUTE 21 WITHIN THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has identified the need for the installation of wet reflective pavement markings along Interstate Route 77 and State Route 21 in Richfield; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. Being in the public interest, Council gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the installation of wet reflective pavement markings along Interstate Route 77 and State Route 21 in Richfield (PID No. 113339 and County/Route/Section D04 PM R-WR FY 2021).
- SECTION 2. The Village shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation as follows: (1) The State of Ohio shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement project and (2) the Village further agrees that 100% of the costs of those features requested by the Village which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the project.
- SECTION 3. The Village agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The Village also understands that right-of way costs include eligible utility costs.
- SECTION 4. Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the Village shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.
- SECTION 5. The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation which are necessary to complete the installation of wet reflective pavement markings along Interstate Route 77 and State Route 21 in Richfield.
- SECTION 6. It was found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in


compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to expedite this highway project and to promote highway safety; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
