A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MONTROSE FORD FOR CAB AND CHASSIS AND AMERICA'S BODY COMPANY FOR BODY AND ELECTRIC/HYDRAULIC CRANE FOR A NEW SEWER TRUCK UNDER THE STATE CUE BID PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Montrose Ford for cab and chassis in the amount of \$27,100.00 and America's Body Company for body and electric/hydraulic crane in the amount of \$19,400.00 for a new sewer truck with equipment as per the State of Ohio CUE Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that its immediately necessary in order to have a needed piece of equipment available to protect Village assets at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
