A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AN EMERGENCY RESCUE VEHICLE UNDER THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES' OFFICE OF PROCUREMENT PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council has budgeted for purchase this year of an emergency rescue vehicle; and

WHEREAS, this Council approves of the purchase of an emergency rescue vehicle through the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services' Office of Procurement Purchasing Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase a 2012 GMC emergency rescue vehicle from Horton Emergency Vehicles through the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services' Office of Procurement Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2. That the purchase of the vehicle through the program is hereby authorized at a cost not to exceed \$161,000.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide a necessary emergency rescue vehicle for the Fire Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in for from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
