

RESOLUTION NO. 7-2012

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO PURCHASE TWO POLICE VEHICLES UNDER THE STATE CUE GROUP PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advertised for bids for the purchase of two police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is a member of the State CUE group purchasing program; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined that police vehicles meeting the needs of the Police Department are available through the State CUE program from Montrose Ford.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Chief of Police be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to purchase two (2) 2012 Ford Taurus vehicles, with police interceptor, package from Montrose Ford through the State CUE program.

SECTION 2. That the purchase of the two (2) vehicles through the program is hereby authorized at a cost not to exceed \$64,000.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason, it is immediately necessary in order to provide for new police vehicles for the safety of the citizens of Richfield at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
