A RESOLUTION DECLARING VILLAGE PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO SELL SAID PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, R.C. 721.15 allows for Council to adopt a Resolution authorizing the sale by Internet auction of personal property, including motor vehicles, and other personal property and equipment which is no longer needed for public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired; and

WHEREAS, in 2021 this Council adopted a resolution authorizing the sale, by Internet auction, of surplus Village personal property which is no longer needed for public use, is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it was acquired and authorized the Mayor to select a representative to conduct such Internet auctions; and

WHEREAS, Council has received a recommendation from the Director of Service that the following Service Department vehicles are no longer needed for public use, or is obsolete, or is unfit for the use for which it were acquired, and thus, is surplus property that should be disposed of:

2001 Freightliner FL70 - VIN # 1FVABTAK71HG78514

2000 Ford F350 pickup truck – VIN # 3FTSF30L5YMA63302

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

- SECTION 1. The 2001 Freightliner FL70 VIN # 1FVABTAK71HG78514 and 2000 Ford F350 pickup truck VIN # 3FTSF30L5YMA63302 are hereby declared surplus property, no longer of useful service to the Village, and, thus, are available for disposition by Internet auction and that the Internet auction shall conducted by GovDeals.com.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the Village can expeditiously dispose of various items of personal property of the Village via Internet auction; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the

Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
