A RESOLUTION URGING AMATS TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE EVERETT ROAD BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield recently was advised that the Ohio Department of Transportation will be rebuilding the Everett Road bridge over Interstate 77 in Bath Township: and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield, the Summit County Council, the Bath Township Trustees, the Richfield Township Trustees and the Revere Board of Education are concerned that the improvement will not provide the width necessary for resident safety; and

WHEREAS, AMATS has some funds available for a change order to ODOT for a contract change to provide for the safety upgrade and increase in width, benefiting all that traverse the bridge.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the Village of Richfield urges AMATS to provide funding for a change order to afford additional width to the Everett Road bridge surface for the safety of residents in the Village.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to serve a certified copy of this Resolution upon AMATS Director Jason Segedy.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
