

RESOLUTION NO. 17-2012

A RESOLUTION WAIVING FORMAL BIDDING AND ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS AND DIRECTING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO OBTAIN QUOTES FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO A SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN IN THE VICINITY OF 4816 BRECKSVILLE ROAD, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer force main in the vicinity of 4816 Brecksville Road is leaking and in need of immediate repair; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 735.051 in the case of a real and present emergency the Village Council may by a two-thirds vote of all members elected thereto authorize a contract for the emergency work to be performed without formal bidding and advertising; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, based on the report and recommendation of the Consulting Engineer and Service Director, that a real and present emergency exists due to the force main leak in the vicinity of 4816 Brecksville Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to seek not less than three quotations from contractors, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, to provide emergency repair to the damaged sanitary sewer force main on an emergency basis, in accordance with plans to be developed by the Consulting Engineer, without the necessity of formal bidding and advertisement.

SECTION 2. That the appropriation of \$100,000.00 from the Sanitary Sewer Fund (DO2), under Cost of Operations, is hereby authorized for such repair.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to repair the sanitary sewer force main at 4816 Brecksville Road; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
