

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE A NEW SQUAD VEHICLE FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a new squad vehicle for the Fire Department is immediately necessary; and

WHEREAS, prices on the squad vehicle are available through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase a new squad vehicle for the Fire Department through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the office of the Fire Chief on an emergency basis.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for the safety of the residents of the Village of Richfield at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
