

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF MONTROSE FORD FOR SALE TO THE VILLAGE OF FOUR (4) POLICE CRUISERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village is a member of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Buying Program; and

WHEREAS, local dealers who can meet or beat the bids for the State Cooperative Buying Program can sell vehicles directly to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received a bid from Montrose Ford for sale to the Village of four (4) Police cruisers in the amount of \$91,980.00, which meets or beats the State Cooperative Buying Program bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase four (4) Police cruisers from Montrose Ford in the amount of \$91,980.00 whose bid meets or beats the State Cooperative Buying Program bid.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the essential operation of the Police Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
