

RESOLUTION NO. 22-2010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADVANCE OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE BRECKSVILLE ROAD (TRAFFIC LIGHTS) FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, funds are needed to fund the Village's share of the construction costs of the Brecksville Road (Traffic Light) Project; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be returned to the General Fund when the Village has received grant money and other funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to advance funds of \$210,000 from the General Fund to the Brecksville Road (Traffic Lights) Fund in order to fund the Village's share of the construction costs.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to pay for an essential safety project.
