

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CINGULAR WIRELESS FOR CO-LOCATION ON THE VILLAGE'S WIRELESS TOWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Cingular has submitted a proposal for co-location on the Village's wireless tower; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Inspector and the Village's Consultant have approved of such plans.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the co-location application of Cingular Wireless for the Village's wireless tower be, and the same hereby is, approved. Further, the building configuration, to the extent that it is different than set forth in the original lease, be, and the same hereby is, approved.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow for revenues come to the Village at the earliest possible time from the Village's co-location fee; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
