

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FINKBEINER PETTIS & STROUT, INC. FOR ENGINEERING FOR A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND CONFIGURATION OF THE INTERSECTION OF COLUMBIA AND BRECKSVILLE ROADS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Finkbeiner Pettis & Strout, Inc. for engineering of a traffic signal and reconfiguration of the intersection of Columbia and Brecksville Roads in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to allow for safer roads at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
