

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDMENT WITH J&J REFUSE TO SERVICE HOMEOWNERS ON FAITH LANE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to enter into an amendment to the contract with J&J Refuse to allow for rubbish pick up for homeowners on Faith Lane conditioned upon J&J Refuse entering into an agreement allowing entry onto the property on Faith Lane and holding the Village harmless.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an amendment to the agreement with J&J Refuse, P. O. Box 448, Dover, Ohio 44622 to allow for trash pick-up and recycling to homeowners on Faith Lane conditioned upon J&J Refuse entering into an agreement with the Faith Lane Condominium Owners Association allowing for J&J Refuse's entry on the property and holding the Village harmless from any claims or liability.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for track pick-up and recycling to homeowners on Faith Lane at the earliest possible date; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
