

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH J&J REFUSE TO ALLOW FOR RECYCLE PICK-UP ON A WEEKLY BASIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Finance Director have recommended to Council that the Village contract with J&J Refuse be amended to allow for recycle pick-up on a weekly basis with a charge to be as quoted in last year's quote and contract of \$9.35.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an amendment of the contract with J&J Refuse, P. O. Box 448, Dover, Ohio 44622 to allow for recycle pick-up on a weekly basis with a charge to be as quoted in last year's quote and contract of \$9.35.

SECTION 2. That all other terms and conditions of the Village refuse hauling contract with J&J Refuse be, and the same hereby remain, in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide a necessary municipal service at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
