

A RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS AND AUTHORIZING RE-ADVERTISEMENT FOR THE TOWN HALL REMODELING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Town Hall Remodeling Project; and

WHEREAS, all bids exceeded by more than ten percent (10%) the Engineer's estimate for the Project; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to reject all bids and authorize re-advertisement of the Project, as revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to reject all bids and re-advertise for the Town Hall Remodeling Project with the plans and Engineer's estimates as revised by the Village's Consulting Engineer.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to have the Town Hall Remodeling Project rebid as promptly as possible to obtain favorable quotations for the Village; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of all members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
