

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF THE KENSINGTON RESERVE DEVELOPMENT UTILITY EASEMENT FOR SANITARY SEWER AND WATER ONLY

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, at its meeting of January 8, 2002, recommended acceptance of the dedication of the Kensington Reserve development utility easement for sanitary sewer and water only; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Inspector and the Village Engineer have recommended acceptance of dedication of this development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Section 3.4.4 of the Subdivision Regulations, the offer of dedication of the final plat of the Kensington Reserve Subdivision utility easement for sanitary sewer and water only be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. That the Village Engineer is authorized and directed to review the final plat pursuant to Section 3.4.5 of the Subdivision Regulations and require the same to be recorded with the County Recorder.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
