A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF DELTA ASPHALT COMPANY, INC. FOR THE HART ROAD/MAPLE DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received on June 22, 2010 for the Hart Road/Maple Drive Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer recommends acceptance of the bid of Delta Asphalt Company, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid in the amount of \$476,678.80.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Delta Asphalt Company, Inc., in the amount of \$476,678.80, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted for the Hart Road/Maple Drive Reconstruction Project.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to commence this important public infrastructure project at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
