

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MONTROSE AUTO GROUP FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 4-DOOR SEDAN ON AN EMERGENCY BASIS FOR THE SENIOR CITIZEN CAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the senior citizen car is no longer operable; and

WHEREAS, the senior citizen car provides an invaluable for transportation to Richfield's senior citizens who are incapable of obtaining other transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to purchase a replacement vehicle for the senior citizen car; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Revised Code Section 735.051.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase of 2002 Chevrolet Impala 4-door sedan from Montrose Auto Group in an amount not to exceed \$17,208.58 on an emergency basis without the necessity of formal bidding and advertisement.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide a vehicle for the senior citizens at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
