

A RESOLUTION CREDITING PHILLIP HRUSH WITH TRANSFER OF SICK LEAVE HOURS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Phillip Hrush has been employed as a new employee in the Service Department; and

WHEREAS, Phillip Hrush is an experienced Service Department employee and has been a valuable hire to the Village of Richfield; and

WHEREAS, as part of the negotiations for the employment of Phillip Hrush, due to his experience and unique qualifications, it was agreed that the Village would credit the sick leave he had previously accumulated with Richfield Township; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to credit Phillip Hrush with the sick leave he had previously accumulated with Richfield Township due to the unique circumstances surrounding his employment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Phillip Hrush is hereby credited with the sick leave he accumulated with Richfield Township as a condition of his hiring and becoming an employee of the Richfield Service Department.

SECTION 2. The Finance Director is authorized to calculate the hours to be credited to Mr. Hrush which are approximately 137.10 hours.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide benefits for an employee; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
