

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 87-2020 THAT ADOPTED A SCHEDULE OF POSITIONS AND COMPENSATION FOR PERSONNEL OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD FOR 2021 TO INCREASE THE MAYOR’S COURT MAGISTRATE’S SALARY AND TO INCLUDE THE POSITION OF MAYOR’S COURT PROSECUTOR AND TO SET THE COMPENSATION FOR THE PROSECUTOR POSITION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council passed Ordinance No. 87-2020 setting forth the Schedule of Positions and Compensation for Village personnel for 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Village intends to resume operations of its Mayor’s Court effective August 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Village’s Administration, Council determines that the Mayor’s Court Magistrate’s salary should be increased to \$200.00 per session all-inclusive and is appropriate and in the best interests of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the position of Mayor’s Court Prosecutor must also be included on the Schedule of Positions and Compensation for Village personnel for 2021 and based on the recommendation of the Village’s Administration, Council determines that the Mayor’s Court Prosecutor’s salary should be set at \$200.00 per session all-inclusive and is appropriate and in the best interests of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 87-2020 adopting the Schedule of Positions and Compensation, bearing a date of December 21, 2020 through December 19, 2021 attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof including the revised Mayor’s Court Magistrate’s salary of \$200.00 per session all-inclusive and the Mayor’s Court Prosecutor Position with compensation for said position set at \$200.00 per session all-inclusive is hereby adopted.


SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts thereof in effect at the time of passage of this ordinance that are in conflict with the foregoing provisions are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3. It was found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to have the revised Mayor's Court Magistrate's salary and Mayor's Court Prosecutor position and compensation reflected in the Schedule of Positions in order to meet the anticipated Mayor's Court reopening of August 1, 2021; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
