

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF J.W. DIDADO ELECTRIC FOR THE PUMP STATION 3 GENERATOR AND PUMP STATION 4 TRANSFER SWITCH PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for the Pump Station 3 Generator and Pump Station 4 Transfer Switch Project; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Service has recommended acceptance of the bid of J.W. Didado Electric in the amount of \$77,750.00 representing a base bid of \$68,365.00 and an alternate bid of \$9,385.00 as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. The bid of J.W. Didado Electric, 1033 Kelly Avenue, Akron, Ohio 44306 in the amount of \$77,750.00 representing a base bid of \$68,365.00 and an alternate bid of \$9,385.00 as being the lowest and best bid and the same is hereby accepted for the Pump Station 3 Generator and Pump Station 4 Transfer Switch Project.
- SECTION 2. The Mayor and Director of Finance are hereby authorized to execute a contract with J.W. Didado Electric., in accordance with the company's bid, and to add a 10% contingency amount to the contract.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to authorize the Pump Station 3 Generator and Pump Station 4 Transfer Switch Project; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


