

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ENGAGEMENT OF FINKBEINER, PETTIS & STROUT, INC. FOR ENGINEERING WORK IN CONNECTION WITH A TRAFFIC LANE AT KINROSS LAKES PARKWAY AND WHEATLEY ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended engineering for a traffic lane at Kinross Lakes Parkway and Wheatley Road; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has further recommended engagement of the engineering firm of Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Inc. for professional engineering services in connection with the engineering and design of the traffic lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to engage the professional engineering firm of Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Inc. for engineering and design of a traffic lane at the corner of Kinross Lakes Parkway and Wheatley Road in an amount not to exceed \$8,000.00.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for traffic safety; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
