PAVEMENT ON STATE ROUTE 176 and STATE ROUTE 303 THROUGH THE VILLAGE
OF RICHFIELD.

The following is a resolution enacted by the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency, in the matter of the state described project.

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

Resurface pavement on SR176 from Cuyahoga County line through Richfield to IR77 and on SR303 from Medina County line through Richfield and Peninsula, to Peninsula east corporation line.

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The LPA agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to not be necessary for the project.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right of Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 65 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION I - Authority to Sign

The Mayor of said Village is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Richfield to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.
