

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE REVERE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE DARE PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a Service Agreement with the Revere School District for the DARE Program, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to be effective for the 2002-2003 school year; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




Service Agreement


This agreement, entered into this 27TH day of June, 2002, by and between the Village of Richfield and the Township of Bath.

In order to provide a quality DARE program in the Revere School District, the Police Departments of Richfield Village and Bath Township have joined together in a cooperative effort. The program developed will require the Village of Richfield to hire a fully qualified, part time DARE Officer to run the program for the 2002-2003 School year. The officer will be paid at the current part time rate indicated in Richfield Salary rate and wage ordinance. Each community agrees to pay one half of the officer's wages for time spent teaching and otherwise participating in the Revere Schools DARE program. Richfield Village and Bath Township further will equally share all related expenses associated with the DARE program, to include T-shirts, graduation items, and other necessary supplies. The Village of Richfield will be responsible for researching and applying for possible DARE Law Enforcement Grant. Any monies received from such grant requests will be equally divided between the named communities to help reduce associated costs incurred by each community. This agreement will remain in effect for a period of one year and is renewable at the discretion of Richfield and Bath Township officials.




