

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH RUMPKE OF NORTHERN OHIO, INC. TO EXTEND THE SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING SERVICE AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village and Rumpke of Northern Ohio (“Rumpke”) executed an agreement for Solid Waste Disposal and Recycling Services (“Agreement”) on November 28, 2017;

WHEREAS, the Agreement between Rumpke and the Village is set for expire on December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Rumpke’s Option Bid No. 2 for solid waste disposal and recycling services, which was incorporated and made part of the contract documents, provided a per unit cost of \$13.49 per month for 2018, 2019, 2020, and a per unit cost of \$14.26 per month for optional years 2021 and 2022; and

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution 93-2020 which authorized the Village and Rumpke to amended the contract in order to exercise optional year 2021; and

WHEREAS, the amended Agreement for optional year 2021 is set for expire on December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Village and Rumpke desire to amended the contract in order to exercise optional year 2022; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of Village of Richfield and necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the Village to authorize the Mayor and Director of Finance to execute the contract amendment to exercise optional year 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit; State of Ohio that:


SECTION 1. The Mayor and Finance Director are authorized and directed to execute the Contract Amendment with Rumpke of Northern Ohio, Inc. for solid waste and recycling services for 2022 substantially in accordance with the Contract Amendment attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that

resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the contract amendment for solid waste disposal and recycling services; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
