

RESOLUTION NO. 52 -2010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AN EMERGENCY GENERATOR REPLACEMENT FOR PUMP STATION NO. 4 – EVERETT ROAD AND BRECKSVILLE ROAD SANITARY SEWER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council has been informed by the Service Director that Pump Station No. 4 in the Everett Road/Brecksville Road Sanitary Sewer is in need of immediate repair; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing conditions constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1 That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase a generator replacement for Pump Station in the Everett Road and Brecksville Road Sanitary Sewer on an emergency basis from W. W. Williams for the generator and from Cummins Bridgeway for rental of a temporary portable generator in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to insure the continued operation of the Everett Road/Brecksville Road Sanitary Sewer; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
