

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR THE INTERIM DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor appointed Laura Toth as the Interim Director of Parks and Recreation, which was not subject to Council confirmation, and

WHEREAS, Ms. Toth is fulfilling the duties of the Director of Parks and Recreation while maintaining her position and job duties as Executive Assistant to the Mayor/Human Resources, Policies, and Records Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, Council recognizes that Ms. Toth's extensive work during the time she will serve as Interim Parks and Recreation Director imposes an unanticipated burden on Ms. Toth; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended and Council desires to compensate Ms. Toth for her services as Interim Parks & Recreation Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. Laura Toth shall be provided \$400.00 per pay period for the services she is providing as Interim Parks and Recreation Director in addition to her compensation as Executive Assistant to the Mayor/Human Resources, Policies, and Records Coordinator, which shall be treated as additional payroll wages with all appropriate deductions being made.
- SECTION 2. Ms. Toth shall receive the additional compensation until the Mayor has appointed a full-time Director of Parks and Recreation, the position is abolished, and/or Ms. Toth is no longer providing the services of Interim Director of Parks and Recreation.
- SECTION 3. Council acknowledges that Laura Toth was appointed Interim Parks and Recreation Director on September 1, 2020 and has been compensated for the services provided since that time and that she is not entitled to any back wages for said services.
- SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to fairly compensate Laura Toth for


fulfilling the duties of Director of Parks and Recreation while maintaining her position and job duties as Executive Assistant to the Mayor/Human Resources, Policies, and Records Coordinator; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
