

A RESOLUTION DECLARING VILLAGE PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY NOT NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DISPOSE OF SAID PROPERTY BY TRADE-IN AND TO APPLY THE TRADE-IN VALUE TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF NEW POLICE DEPARTMENT SERVICE RIFLES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village intends to purchase twelve (12) new service rifles for sworn Police Department personnel from Vance's Law Enforcement through the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, Vance's has agreed to accept the Police Department's old service rifles and to apply the trade-in value of \$3,400 toward the purchase price of the new service rifles; and

WHEREAS, the total purchase price for the twelve (12) new service rifles is \$7,980.40 after the trade-in value is applied; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended to Council that the following Colt AR-15 Rifles are surplus property not necessary for public use and should be disposed by trade-in with Vance's:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. This Council finds that Colt AR-15 Rifles set forth above of the Village identified above are surplus property not necessary for public use that should be disposed of by trade-in.


SECTION 2. The Mayor is authorized and directed to dispose of the surplus property by trade-in with Vance's Law Enforcement and to apply the trade-in value toward the purchase price of the twelve (12) new Police Department service rifles.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that

resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that the Village can apply the trade-in value toward the outstanding invoice from Vance's Law Enforcement for the new service rifles; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
