

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 100-2021 AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR AN EMPLOYEE HOLIDAY PARTY TO AUTHORIZE THE ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution No. 100-2021 on October 19, 2021 authorizing the Mayor to expend up to \$1,200 for an employee Holiday party; and

WHEREAS, due to rising COVID-19 infection rates, the Mayor decided to purchase boxed lunches for Village employees instead of hosting a holiday party in order to minimize the risk of transmission of COVID-19 among employees; and

WHEREAS, a result, the cost of the employee Holiday lunch was \$1,712.00, which exceeded the amount of funds authorized by Council; and

WHEREAS, Council determines that the increased cost for the Holiday boxed lunches was necessary and that the expenditure of the additional funds constitute a valid public purpose for the expenditure of Village funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. Resolution 100-2021 authorizing the Mayor to expend \$1,200.00 in Village funds for an employee Holiday lunch is amended to authorized the increased expenditure of funds to \$1,712.00.
- SECTION 2. All prior versions of Resolution 100-2021 and any other any ordinance or resolution to the contrary are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing the additional expenditure of funds; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


